REQUIREMENTS FOR ABSTRACTS

Structure::

- Surname and name of the author (authors) on the left, italics.
- Title of the report (symmetrical to the text, capital letters, bold).
- Abstract (250-300 characters) and keywords (3-5) in abstract language and English (italics).
- Sources and literature.

Technical parameters::

- Volume of text - 2-3 pages.
- Set - in the WORD editor as a computer file with the extension * .doc
- Font - Times New Roman, size 14,
- Line spacing - 1; margins - 2 cm, paragraph - 1.25 cm.
- The list of involved sources and literature is given in alphabetical order. Bibliographic description is carried out in accordance with the National Standard "Information and documentation. Bibliographic link. General provisions and rules of compilation. DSTU 8302: 2015 ».
- References to sources and literature in the text should be given in square brackets - [16, 27], where the first number means their ordinal number in the final list, the second - the page number (sheet), where the information is taken.

Upon receipt of applications for participation in the conference and their consideration, participants will be sent an official invitation to the e-mail specified in the application.
